Request for Expression of Interest (EOI)

In the context of significantly increasing the access to and affordability of artemisinin based combination antimalarial drug products (ACTs), **Roll Back Malaria (RBM) Partners** are inviting **Expressions of Interest** from manufacturers of artemisinin-based antimalarial products who would benefit from receiving technical assistance to conform to international standards.

Manufacturers are encouraged to submit letters of expression of interest for various forms of technical assistance in the categories listed below:

- Preparation of documentation leading to manufacturer's license for production of artemisinin-based antimalarial products as required by national regulatory authorities
- Preparation of dossiers for registration or marketing authorization/licensure in accordance with national requirements
- Manufacturing antimalarial products in compliance with WHO Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP)
- Product dossiers preparation to acceptable quality for approval by the UN Prequalification of artemisinin-based antimalarials

Interested manufacturers should send a letter of intent to receive technical assistance and providing details of products manufactured to:
