 - Deployment and motivation of staff (Tendering/Ordering of LLIN,ACTs in time)
 - Thorough Distribution plans for(Delivery to the people in need)
4. **Capacity Building in M&E**
 - ACT & RDT consumption and forecasting(burden reduction)
5. **Capacity building and planning in hang up & community empowerment**
 - LLIN utilisation and ACTs Adherence



SUPPORT FROM GLOBAL PARTNERSHIP
