The delivery of a global report on progress towards 2010 targets relates to the convening of a “high-level event” in September 2011

- In 2008, the RBM Global Malaria Action Plan restated RBM 2010 goals and targets and the UN Secretary General called for Universal Coverage of malaria prevention and control by the end of 2010.
- The May 2009 RBM Board approved in principle the convening of a “high-level event” in September 2011, linked to the UN General Assembly, to report on progress towards these targets – delivering a report to the global community.

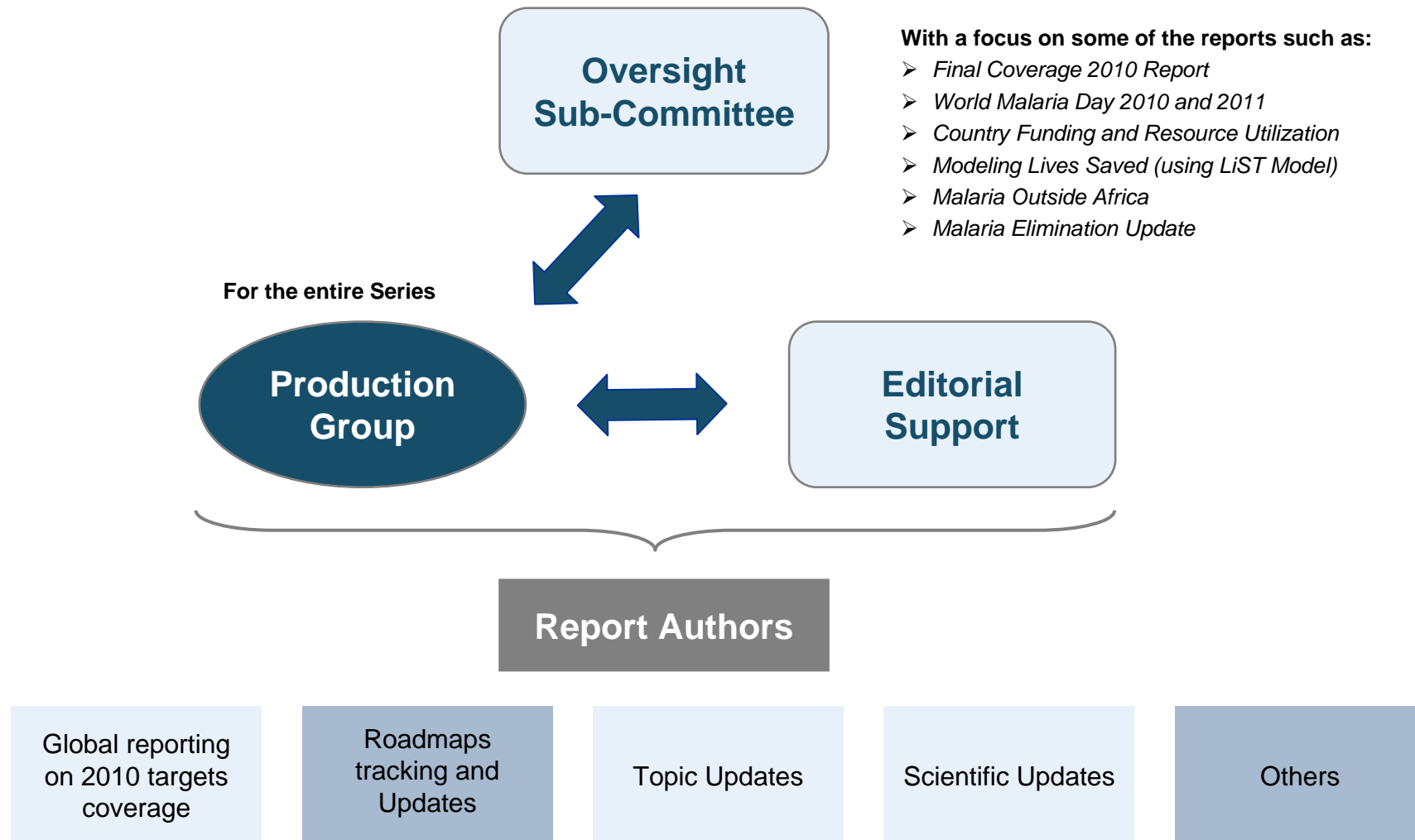
There is much enthusiasm in the RBM community to showcase progress toward the RBM goals.

A Board Oversight Sub-Committee for 2010 Reporting was proposed in May 2009 to provide strategic direction and Board oversight

- **An RBM Board Oversight Sub-Committee for 2010 Reporting was proposed in May 2009 to provide strategic direction and Board oversight to these issues:**
 - This committee will include chairs of the MERG, MAWG and HWG to ensure full engagement of these working groups.
 - The Oversight Sub-Committee will guide the resource mobilization efforts of the Board related to the tasks of this committee, monitor workplans and budgets, and review draft reports.

- **It is critical to ensure coordination among partners regarding the expectations, roles, content and tone for:**
 - The audience(s), use(s) and timing of the reports and updates;
 - The priority content of the reports and updates;
 - The convening of high-level event(s) to communicate this information to the appropriate stakeholders.

The production of reports series will be managed by a core team under the strategic direction of the Board Oversight Sub-Committee



RBM partners (with HWG, MAWG and MERG engagement) will develop reports linking with existing events until September 2011

All reports will have common characteristics as part of the “Progress and Impacts Report” Series

➤ **Structure:**

- ~3-5 page summary
- Final report for September 2011 HLE: ~50 pages
- WMD and Topic updates: ~20-35 pages

➤ **Languages:**

- All reports will be available in both English and French
- Other translation needs will be assessed: e.g. Portuguese, Spanish and Arabic.

➤ **Packaging:**

- Similar design and layout
- Hard copies + electronic and web versions

➤ **Frequency:**

- Some already have timelines
- Approximately one-two reports per quarter betw. Jan 2010 and Sept. 2011
