

## Summary of Global ACT Subsidy Taskforce decision points

- *Endorsed* the subsidy objectives and design principles
- *Expressed* continued support for the introduction of a global subsidy for ACTs according to those principles and objectives
- *Approved* the continuation of the RBM Global ACT Subsidy Taskforce:
  - As the only RBM mechanism to forge consensus on;
  - To guide the finalization of a detailed technical proposal including governance and hosting arrangements, funding requirements, formal linkage with and costing of supporting activities, and any other outstanding operational issues;
  - To submit for approval a detailed technical plan for the launch of the subsidy to the November 2007 RBM Board.

## Summary of Global ACT Subsidy Taskforce next steps

- June: submission of draft detailed technical proposal to the RBM Executive Committee
- July - October: finalize arrangements for governance, hosting, funding and supporting activities
- July - October: further research to support introduction of subsidy
- November: submit final detailed technical proposal to the RBM Board
- November: announce the subsidy
